1. Call to order – 6:00

3. Approval of minutes from last meeting - unanimous
4. Old business
 - a. Annual convention programming
 - i. Third Annual NP/Board wine social
 - ii. First Annual MiniGolf Tournament – need to work out the details for this in the next few weeks so we can plan. Would like to do awards during the BBQ with the other sports day awards (high/low score, most likely to miss par, most likely to hit the water, etc). Need to figure out sponsorship of holes and how that would work. **PSSNY office needs to know about awards soon.**
 - iii. CE day programming
 1. Self-care Jeopardy – since CE is not lined up yet and this is already CE accredited, this will be in the main CE lineup sponsored by the NPN. Each school will be invited to send a team of students with a local NP for a captain to compete. If sponsorship comes through, would like to get audience response system to allow the teams to poll the audience for a lifeline, can split them along alumni lines with WSOP getting alumni from out of state and the NY schools no longer around if it works out well. This would cost ~\$3,000. Consider asking Andy Flynn to be MC. (2 hrs)
 2. Preceptor training – this was also brought up by the Academicians, and they will pursue it. We would like to be able to identify it in the program as suggested for NPs or NPN recommended, but we will not be cosponsoring it. Jen Cerulli may be the speaker (1.5 hrs)
 3. While not sponsored by the NPN, wound care is also a topic that will be pursued for the convention (1.5 hrs)
 4. there will also be 2.5 additional hours of CE, potentially some on counseling/communication, which we can also designate as NPN recommended
 - iv. Student Round Table – Due to the Self-care CE, we are not planning additional programming on CE day.
 - b. Request from Tammy Lee Demler, PSSNY President – she is looking for a slogan to use to promote pharmacy (think “got milk”). Still no ideas, keep thinking.
 - c. Annual Legislative Day in Albany (3/27/07)
 - i. More details on the health fair will be available next week. We do know that there will be 6 brown bag tables, 6 informational tables,

and possibly lunch. We will have students there as well, but will need 12 pharmacists at all times.
